Announcing the MindMax Research Fellowship Proposal

- As announced at the annual conference in St. Louis, NAASS, in partnership with <u>MindMax</u> <u>LLC</u>, is <u>sponsoring research</u> intended to advance Association members' understanding of the role of summer and intersessional programming in the advancement of student progress and student success in higher education.
- <u>The fellowship</u> has an overall duration of fifteen (15) months including a 3-month startup window. The total value of the fellowship award is a maximum of ten thousand US dollars (US \$10,000).
- The submitted research budget may include individual stipend, as well as equipment, travel, and other related expenses that can be demonstrated as being directly related to work for the proposed research objective.
